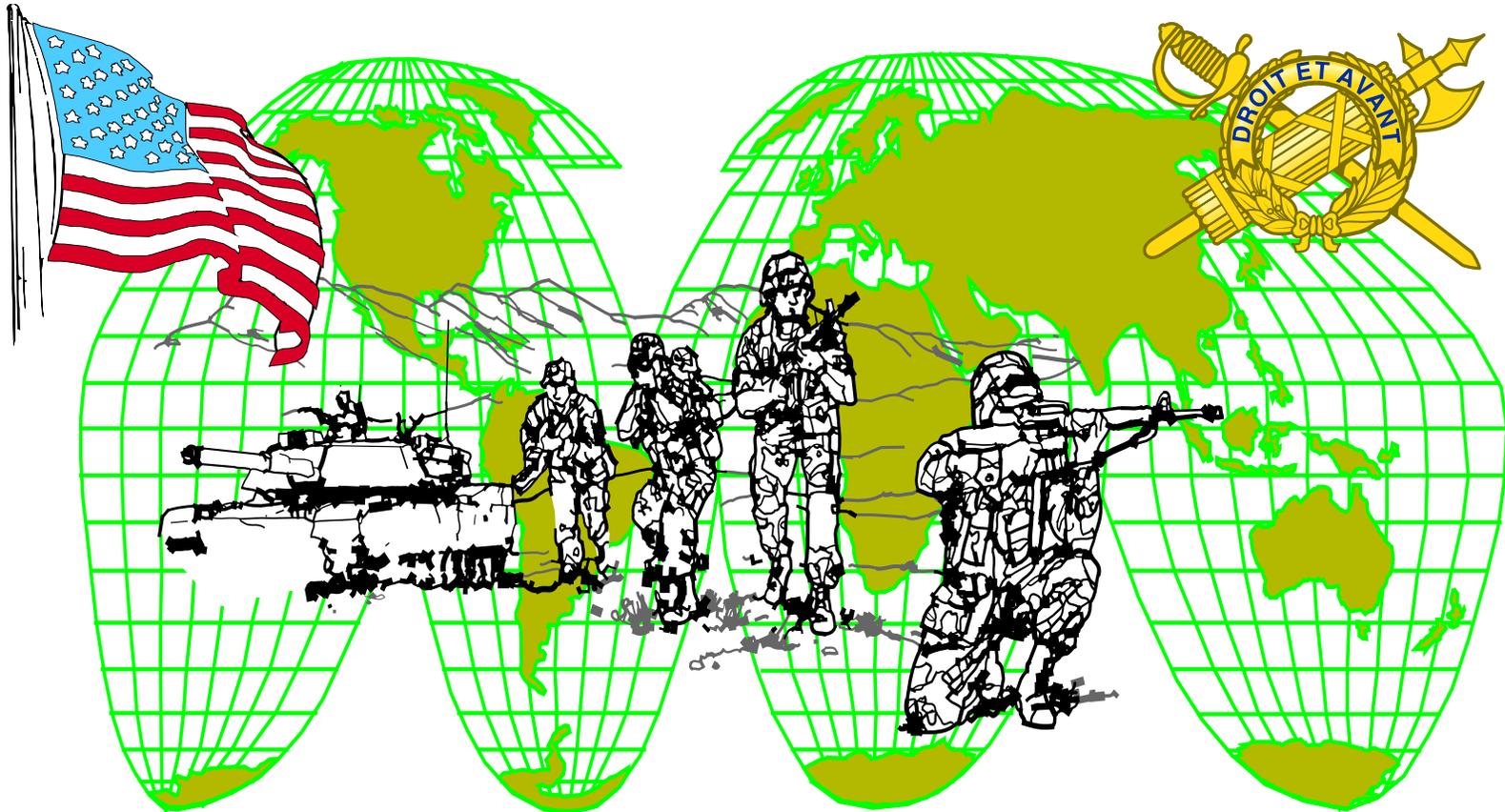

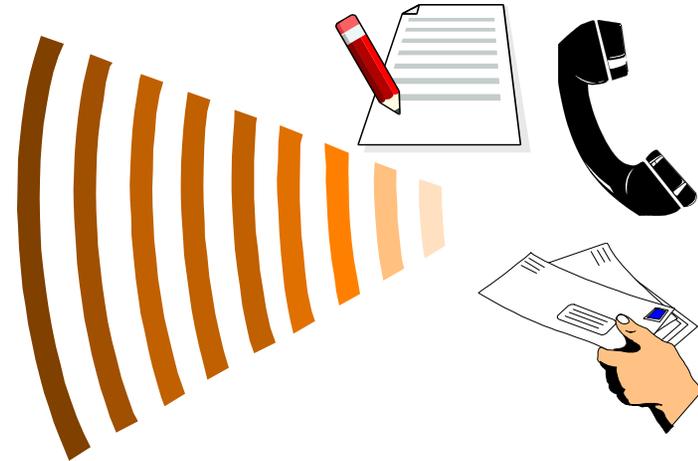

IG Assistance

“... Anyone may submit a complaint, allegation, or request for assistance to any Army IG concerning matters of Army interest ...” -AR 20-1



- **Assist soldiers, civilians and families**
- **Identify errors, or inconsistencies**
- **Eliminate conditions detrimental to the Army's efficiency and effectiveness**

- FY 02**
Over 30,000 IG Action Requests
The "Top 5" Requests
- **Personnel management**
 - **Personal conduct**
(10% of all IG Action Requests were "Nonsupport of family")
 - **Finance/accounting**
 - **Cmd/mgmt of organization**
 - **Healthcare/TRICARE**

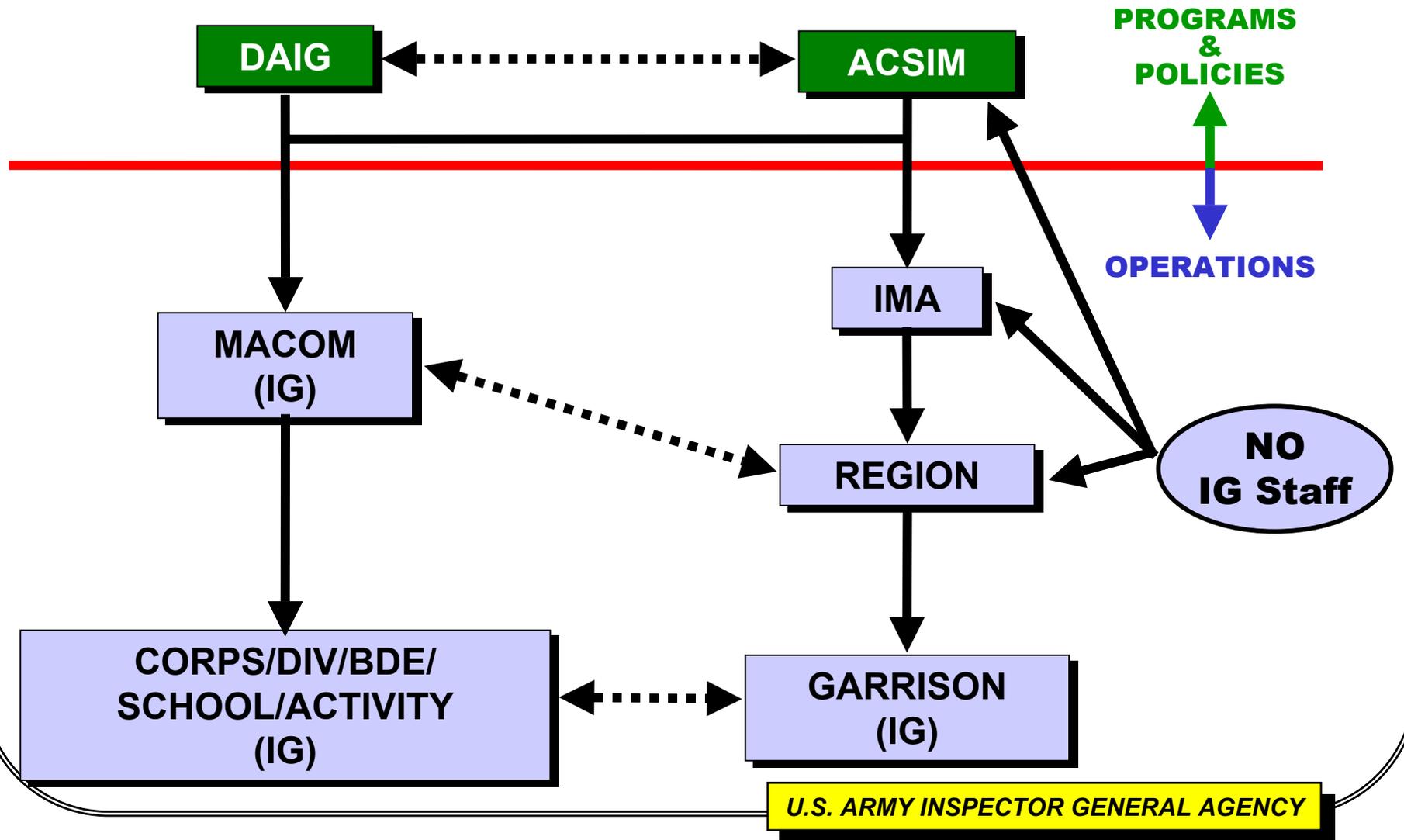


- **Expanded and evolving roles**

- **Fact finding process, determine truth**
- **Present findings**
- **Protect parties involved (*confidentiality*)**
- **Not used for disciplinary action or in lieu of AR 15-6**
 - ★ **Separate rules for Senior Officials**

Root Causes

- **Mission-driven – Knowingly violates a standard**
- **Mission-driven – Unknowingly violates a standard**
- **Overzealous Personal Staff**
- **Ego**

Recent DAIG Inspections



Risk Management

- **Command emphasis directly effects the quality of the RM process at an installation.**
- **Units not completing corrective actions portion of the Army Accident report (DA Form 285) to standard or reporting any meaningful actions taken**
- **Application of RM doctrine (FM 100-14) varies**

Individual Soldier Readiness

- **Required annual training, medical/dental certifications and soldier readiness checks not completed to standard**
- **OER/NCOER timeliness is a serious challenge**
- **Good programs to ensure conditionally promoted soldiers attend NCOES within required timelines**

Recent DAIG Inspections



Anti-terrorism/Force Protection

- Major Changes/updates to AR 525-13 are needed
- Army AT policy and procedures not supported with doctrine/TTP
- Inadequate exercises

Organizational Inspection Program

- With few exceptions, OIPs not conducted to standard
- About 50% of Command Inspections do not comply with AR 1-201 regulatory guidance
- Routine and fundamental requirements ignored
- Inconsistent follow-up of compliance inspection deficiencies

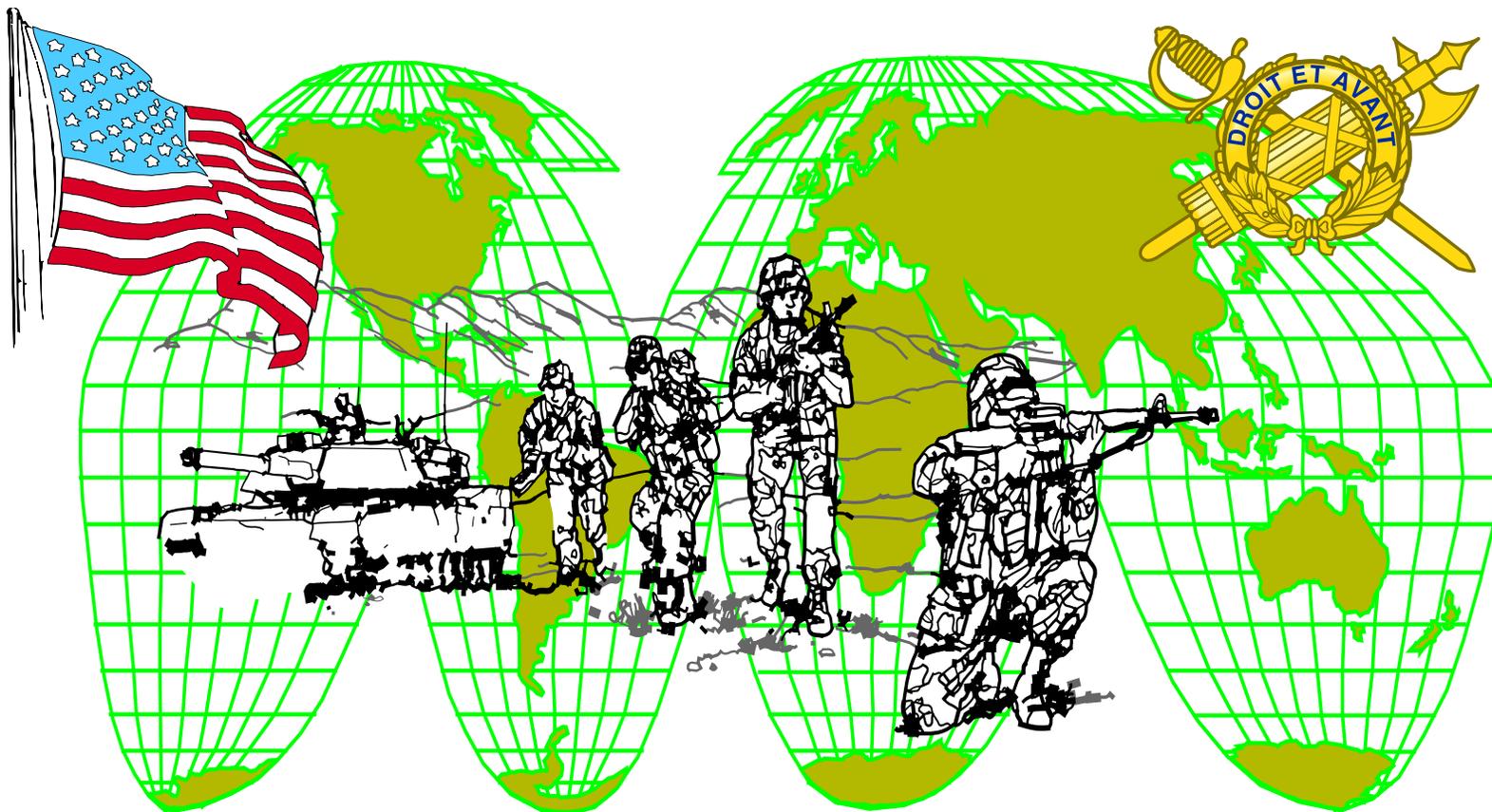
